Futurity and Yearling Challenge Rules

ENTRY RULES

Open to AQHA and APHA (SPB and Regular Registry). Note: there is no longer a requirement for APHA horses to enter a class. AN OFFICE FEE MUST BE PAID BY ALL FUTURITY HORSES - IF HORSE IS NOT SHOWING IN APHA CLASS - \$50.00 OFFICE FEE APPLIES. Early Entry Deadline postmarked on or before July 17th or double entry fee to 6 pm on August 2.

SCORING RULES

There will be one go for performance futurities (3 judges)

Must show to all 3 judges, if not entry fee remains in the purse but that entry is not eligible for a payout

Halter futurity will be one go under 3 judges

No ties will be allowed on the judges' card. A tie-breaker judge will be drawn and will be used for awards only, monies will be split equally

Points will be awarded as shown below:

1st - 66 points, 2nd - 55 points, 3rd - 45 points, 4th - 36 points, 5th - 28 points, 6th - 21 points, 7th - 15 points, 8th - 10 points

PERFORMANCE RULES

Snaffle bit is defined as: a smooth or single twisted bit with a broken mouth piece, minimum 5/16 inch diameter. The snaffle bit must be such that when the reins are pulled, there is no leverage applied.

If a curb strap is used, it must be below the reins, and it must be leather, braided nylon, or chain, all to be no less than 1/2 inch and to lie flat against the jaw. No martingales, nosebands or other training devices to be used.

Hackamore is to be a rawhide or leather braided or rope bosal. No iron permitted under the jaw regardless of how padded or taped.

Western Pleasure Horses exhibited at the walk, jog, lope and back. Hunter Under Saddle exhibited at the walk, trot, canter and back.

Non-Pro Exhibitors must provide a copy of their APHA Youth or Amateur (or AQHA Youth or Amateur) before being considered entered as non-pro.

All Ages Hunter Under Saddle and All Ages Western Pleasure are a Non-pro futurity and Open futurity combined. Hi Point Non-Pro exhibitor will receive a significant award in addition to being eligible for the open futurity payouts.

Futurity horses will receive a warm up (set out on roster). Tack will be checked and horses will enter down the centre of the arena. Any horse with illegal tack will be excused. After horses have entered the arena no physical contact with people outside the arena is allowed.

NON PRO SHOWMANSHIP RULES

Open to AQHA and APHA (SPB and Regular Registry) Youth, Novice Amateur and Amateurs. APHA Showmanship rules apply.

ALL GENDER YEARLING HALTER RULES

Open to AQHA and APHA (SPB and Regular Registry).

YEARLING CHALLENGE

Open to APHA Solid Paint Bred and Regular Registry. Early Entry - \$200 due May 1 and \$200 due July 1 or \$600 on or before 6pm on August 2, 2017. Longeline and Trail In Hand scores from APHA classes (SPB and RR) will be combined and horses placed accordingly. Points attributed to placings based on number of horses shown. Halter points will be based on placings in the Yearling Challenge Halter class (under all 3 judges). Hi Point Non Pro exhibitor will receive an award. Calcutta will be held during the Exhibitor Social on Thursday after the completion of Trail, details to be posted.

By entering the Zone 10 Zone O Rama futurities/yearling challenge, horse owners acknowledge the right and give permission to the managers of the show to do drug testing on any or all entries, randomly or in any manner decided upon by management. APHA rulebook guidelines will be used.

Zone 10 Zone O Rama, Zone 10 Paint Horse Committee and APHA will in no case be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to horses exhibited, or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, stolen, destroyed or in any way injured. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury or damage done to or occasioned by, or arising from any horses or articles owned or exhibited by that exhibitor and shall indemnify the APHA, the Zone 10 Zone O Rama, the Zone 10 Paint Horse Committee and the Ponoka Ag Event Centre, sponsors and their associates.
