High Point Non Pro Award

- open to any APHA yearling (solid paint bred or regular registry)
- copy of registration papers must be provided. If non pro or youth copy of APHA card required.
- cheques payable to **Zone 10 Paint Horse Committee**
- Trail In Hand and Longeline, Yearling Challenge Halter will have 1 go under 3 judges
- Longeline and Trail in Hand scores will be combined from the Solid Paint Bred and Regular Registry score cards and entries will be placed accordingly with points being awarded based on the number of horses competing (e.g. 20 horses, 1st place receives 20 points; 2nd place receives 19 points, etc.). In the event of ties in class scores, placings/scores will be averaged between the tied entries (e.g. 20 horses, 1st 72 points, 2nd 71 points, 2 horses have 70 points is a 3rd/4th tie. 1st place 20 points; 2nd place 19 points; 3rd/4th place tie 17.5 points each)
- Yearling Challenge Halter class points awarded based on the number of horses
- Ties determined on most highest places (e.g. most 1sts)
- Calcutta (Payout half to winning entry and half to winning buyer - for all placings receiving payout)
- No restriction on number of horses any exhibitor may show in Longeline and Trail in Hand
- Same Payout Structure as futurities

Payment Schedule: All entry fees less 10% added to purse

Early entry: \$400.00 payable, \$200 postdated on or before June 1st & \$200 postdated on or before July 1st

Late entry: (if either of early payments not made on time) \$600.00 payable on or before 6:00 p.m. August 1
